Jim attended Southwester Baptist Theological Seminary in Ft. Worth, Texas. They are the parents of five grown children and four grandchildren.

Jim has been a pastor for over 30 years. He has spoken at revivals, Bible and Fulness Conferences, youth, family, couples and home school conferences. Jim has served churches in Missouri, Arkansas, Indiana and Texas. Among some of the churches served has been as the founding Pastor of the Eastvue Baptist Church of Joplin, Missouri, Co-Pastor of the Graceland Baptist Church of New Albany, Indiana, Oak Grove, Baptist Church in Nacogdoches, Texas, First Baptist Church of Ferguson in St. Louis, Missouri, and Macedonia Baptist Church in Springfield, Missouri. He formerly served as the Ministerial Service Specialist with the Missouri Baptist Convention. He is presently Senior Pastor of the Covenant Baptist Church in Mount Vernon, Missouri. He has hosted the *Life Through Christ* daily radio program and formerly was the speaker for the *Think About Tomorrow* Television program that was broadcast throughout Missouri and Illinois.

The Carters have conducted nearly 70 **Forever in Love** Couples Conferences, **Family Legacy** and **Pastor and Wife** Conference in 14 states and two foreign countries. Jim has spoken in 18 states with **Life Through Christ Ministry**. They have been appointed as North American Board Missionaries of the Southern Baptist Convention.

Family Legacy Conferences, is a conference that is designed to review the unique needs of the entire family. The conference is structured to speak to the needs of men and women, the husband and wife, grandparents, the single adult, parents relationship to their children, children's responsibilities to their parents and issues relating to teenagers.
