Some ideas include: something to love (teddy bear or doll), something for school (colored pencils, pencil cases), something to wear (t-shirt, caps) something to play with (cars, jump ropes), something for personal hygiene (soap, hair clips, brush), and something special (necklaces, sunglasses).

You might be shopping and spot some of these ideas or other items that might delight a child that otherwise would not get anything for Christmas. All of the boxes that are prepared for 'Operation Christmas Child', will be delivered to under developed countries all over the world.
