A young man sat on the side of a dirt road. He wasn't welcome in his own home or village. He was diseased and disfigured—he was a leper. He had no money for food, and no one would provide him with shelter. He sat on his mat each day, begging for food and water. Day in and day out, people passed him as if he didn't exist. He lived moment to moment, not knowing what was going to happen to him. As he sat there, a new building was being built behind a hospital, a building for people with leprosy. When the hospital was ready to receive patients a young doctor came to the edge of town, picked up the man, and carried him to the hospital. The doctor placed him in a bed, and gave him food and water. The man was shocked that the doctor touched him because it meant that he too, would be ostracized by the village. The leper thanked the doctor and said he would be on his way so that no one would know that the doctor had touched him. The doctor sat with the leper and told him about *Someone* who loved him unconditionally, loved him just as he was, and loved him enough to die on the cross for him. That day, because the doctor loved the leper as Jesus loved him, the leper asked Jesus into his heart. As believers, we are called to love as Jesus does. It starts first with loving Jesus.
